Criteria for Inclusion in Doctor Directory

The Chordoma Foundation's Medical Advisory Board has determined that in order to be listed in the Chordoma Foundation Doctor Directory, a physician must attest that he or she meets the following qualifications:

- 1. Board certified in neurosurgery, otolaryngology, radiation oncology, orthopedic surgery or medical oncology.
- 2. Fellowship in a relevant subspecialty (e.g. skull base surgery) or at least five years of subspecialty practice experience
- 3. Has personally treated ten or more chordoma patients in the past five years
 - a. This does not include patients for whom consultation but no direct treatment was provided or patients treated by partners
 - b. Multiple procedures performed on a single patient only count as one patient
- 4. Has a commitment to improving the treatment of chordoma as demonstrated by at least one of the following in the past five years:
 - a. Published a peer-reviewed journal article on chordoma
 - b. Presented on chordoma at a national or international conference
 - c. Attended a Chordoma Foundation conference
